Content

TOEFL: You will learn specific strategies for this American examination, with an emphasis on enriching vocabulary and listening skills. During the course you will have

comprehensive examination practice with feedback from your teacher. Lessons give background information on American culture and the differences between British and American English are explored.

Academic English: You will learn the language skills required for academic study, such as summarising lectures, note-taking skills, essay writing, debating techniques, carrying

out research and presenting data and using the Internet where appropriate. Students are encouraged to discover the learning strategies that suit them best, so that they can learn more effectively.

Registering for the examination

We will help you to register for the TOEFL Examination on the first day of your course, but we cannot guarantee there will be a place on your preferred day. To be certain of a particular day, **we recommend that you register and pay for the examination 8 weeks in advance** by telephone to the TOEFL Europe office in Holland: + 31 320 239 540 or on their website: www.ets.org/toefl. You must pay by credit or debit card. The examination will take place in the City of London, near Cannon Street Underground. Examinations take place on most days from Monday to Friday of each week and some Saturdays.
