Location of Part-time English

This course is held in our Kensington schools year round except during July and August.

Some attention is paid to students' reading and writing skills where appropriate but the emphasis is on developing their listening and speaking abilities through a variety of classroom activities. Typical areas of language include; travelling, socialising, formal and informal meetings and telephoning. The course rapidly progresses through relevant language areas and topics are chosen of interest to the students in the group.
