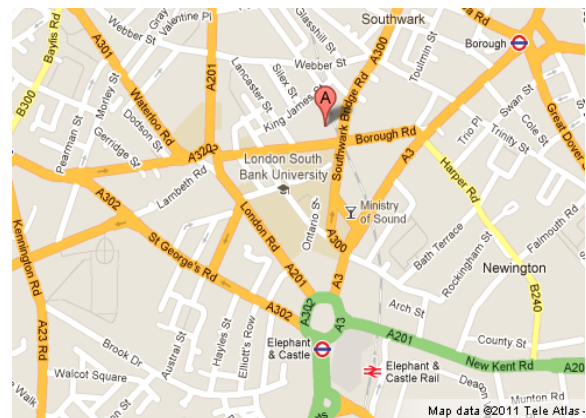

Friendship House is a new, modern architect designed, self-catering residence. Well situated in historic and modest Southwark it is close to a number of underground stations including Southwark, Elephant and Castle, Borough and Waterloo, giving easy access to both the City and the West End. The Tate Modern Gallery, the Globe Theatre and Southwark Cathedral are in easy walking distance. The House has accommodation for 179 residents. Situated a 20-30min underground trip from our schools.



Accommodation information*

Type of accommodation

Friendship House is a popular modern student residence with a special appeal towards mixed age groups. Located next to South Bank University.

Kitchen / Meals

Well equipped kitchens shared between 8-10 residents. Each kitchen has a large fridge, 2 ovens, microwave, 2 kettles and a seating area with table and chairs. Students are given a kitchen pack on arrival which includes cooking utensils.

Rooms / Facilities

Single rooms are small, simply furnished and with an en-suite shower room. The rooms all have a flat-screen digital television, desk area, mini-fridge and mini-freezer.

Bathrooms

Small private bathroom with a shower cubicle.

Utilities

The accommodation fee includes electricity, gas and water. Please note that the electrical current is 240 volts AC (50 cycles) and students from some countries may require a transformer and a plug adaptor.

Internet / Telephone

Free internet connection via cable in all bedrooms. Cable can be purchased from reception. WIFI is not available. Public pay phone for outgoing calls only.

Laundry and cleaning

Rooms and kitchens are cleaned 5 times per week. Bed linen is supplied and changed fortnightly, but students must bring their own towels.

Security and keys

There is 24-hour security.

Deposit

£30 returnable key and damage deposit, payable in cash on arrival.

Arrival and departure

Check-in must be after 11.30am and students must vacate the residence by 10.30am on their day of departure. Students arriving any time after 2pm will need to call the main number provided upon arrival.

Visitors/guests

Students may have daytime visitors until 10.30pm, at which time they must leave. Students are on special occasions allowed

an overnight guest for £10 (arranged in advance).

Noise and restrictions

Students are requested to be considerate to their neighbours and keep noise levels to a minimum especially after 10 pm.

Availability

Friendship House is offered year-round to students aged 18 and over. Bookings should be for a minimum of 2 weeks

Notice

If a student cancels after arrival, they will need to give 2 weeks' notice to a Frances King Advisor. Full terms and conditions as per Frances King Enrolment Details, Terms and Conditions 2012.
