You will also learn specific strategies to improve your examination performance, with comprehensive examination practice and feedback from your teacher. You can take the examination in the week following the end of your course.

Academic English: You will learn the language skills required for academic study, such as summarising lectures, note-taking skills, essay writing, debating techniques, carrying out research and presenting data and using the Internet where appropriate. Students are encouraged to discover the learning strategies that suit them best, so that they can learn more effectively.
